## Attended 4 meetings

Dom Paulinus Angold was born Dunstan Angold in Kingston upon Hull on December  $22^{nd}$  1913.

He entered Buckfast Abbey in 1931 and was ordained in 1937, taking the monastic name of Paulinus.

During the Second World War, he spent two and a half years in Egypt, in the desert, as an army chaplain. He also served as an army chaplain in Italy. After the war, he returned to Buckfast and served as a parish priest in Ashburton and Buckfastleigh.

He worked in the stained glass workshops at the Abbey.

He enjoyed ringing bells and visited many Devon churches.

He died on 18<sup>th</sup> December 2009 and at the time of his death was the oldest monk in the English Benedictine Order.
