Tom George Bartlett was born in Devon in 1880.

He learned to ring at Heavitree, Exeter around 1900, but later transferred to St. Sidwells.

When the Cathedral band at Exeter was reformed in 1915, he applied to be a member and remained a member of that band until his death. For much of that time he was the treasurer of the band.

At one time he was the treasurer of the Guild of Devonshire Ringers; he also served as chairman of the Exeter branch. He became a Vice-President of the Guild.

He was renowned for his punctuality and regular attendance for ringing.

He earned his living as a railway clerk.

He died on February 28th 1957 and his funeral was held on March 4th.
