Charles Binyon was born at Burton in Lonsdale, Yorkshire in 1874.

He learned to ring in 1905 at Badsey in Worcestershire, where he rang his first peal on 25th May 1926.

He was on the Worcestershire Association Central Committee 1929-1932.

He was on the Bell Inspection Panel from 1927 and was secretary of his local band from 1921 for many years.

He was a J.P. in Worcester in 1912.

He served on the Bishop of Worcester's Advisory Committee for several years from 1925 and was a useful contact between ringers and antiquarian authorities.

He served on the Evesham Rural District Council from 1904 and was chairman from 1926 for some years.

He was a market gardener by trade.

He died in the Evesham area in 1963.
