Keith Nicholas Buckingham was born on 16th January 1958 at Wallsend on Tyne.

He learned to ring at Springfield near Chelmsford, then moved to Retford and rang his first peal at Babworth on 1st May 1976.

Later he moved to Lincolnshire and rang at Horncastle and then Alford. After he moved to Shropshire, he rang at Shrewsbury and Church Stretton.

He taught many people to ring and was an enthusiastic organiser, arranging many quarter peal days in Lincolnshire.

He was President of the Eastern Branch of the Lincoln Diocesan Guild 1996-2001; he was Ringing Master of the Eastern Branch in 1987 and 1994-1995.

He was Master of the Lincoln Diocesan Guild 2002-2005.

He rang in a record peal of 20,160 Grandsire Triples in 1991.

He rang a total of 444 peals of which he conducted 16.

In 2003 he was elected a member of the Ancient Society of College Youths.

He worked for Lloyds bank and later became an independent financial adviser.

He died on 25th July 2007 and his funeral was on August 2nd at Church Stretton.
