Attended 15 meetings

Born at Darnall, Sheffield on 28th July 1910;.

Began ringing at Felkirk, Yorkshire in 1920.

Subsequently attached to Wakefield Cathedral.

Rang his first peal on 26th February 1927: Plain Bob Minor at Felkirk.

Rang a total of 297 peals including 120 on handbells.

His notable achievements include ringing a peal of 10800 Surprise Minor in 15 methods (Rotherham, 1.1.1931).

He had a special interest in splicing minor methods.

He was a well known striking competition judge.

He was in the Ringing World article 'Servants of the Exercise' No 45 (RW 4.11.1960).

As 'Professor' and 'I.N. Quick' he wrote articles for The Ringing World.

Occupation: Builder and teacher.

Died on 6th October 1988.
