## **The Revd. HENRY JOHN CHEALES**

Representative of the Lincoln Diocesan Guild 1900 -1903

Attended 0 meetings

Henry John Cheales was born 27<sup>th</sup> October 1829.

He was the Vicar of Friskney in Lincolnshire, where there is a stained glass window in his memory on which it is stated:

‘Henry John Cheales M.A. (Oxon). Born 1829. Died 1910.  
Vicar of Friskney 1869-1899, and Rural Dean ,  
through whose efforts this church was restored in 1879.’

He was Vice-President of the Lincoln Diocesan Guild 1899-1910 and at the same time was President of the Eastern Branch.

He was not a ringer.

He died on 16<sup>th</sup> April 1910 and is buried in Friskney churchyard with his wife.
