John Henry Crampion (Jack) was born at Woodford, Essex on 20th February 1911.

He began ringing at Woodford in 1925 and was subsequently attached to Wanstead 1935-1946, Leytonstone 1946-1957, St Paul's Cathedral from 1946 and Westminster Abbey from 1950 to 1991.

Rang his first peal on 30th November 1929: Stedman Caters at St Mary, Walthamstow.


He rang a total of 506 peals.

Jack was a member of band for the first peal of Spliced Surprise Royal (St Magnus, London 25.7.1931); he rang 12,740 Plain Bob Royal (Prittlewell 7.8.1950). He rang about 40 peals with William Pye's band.

He circled the tower to peals at St Paul's Cathedral, London.
