

Biographical Record

Harold DENMAN (1903 - 1995)

Represented the North Nottinghamshire Association in 1945 and the Southwell Diocesan Guild from 1946 - 1950. He attended 0 meetings

Born at Rockley, Nottinghamshire on 5th April 1903.

Began ringing at North Muskham in 1924.

Subsequently attached to Gamston from 1925.

Rang his first peal on 23rd March 1929: 3 Minor methods at Gamston.

Rang a total of 477 peals including 407 of Minor.

His notable achievements include: peal of 7200 Treble Bob Minor in 10 methods (Gamston, 2.3 1957); rang in many first peals for both the Southwell Guild and North Notts Association including Forward Major and Gainsborough Little Bob Major; rang in a peal for the Coronation of George VI, starting at 6am (Plain Bob Major, Sutton-on-Trent, 12.5.1937).

Occupation: Foreman with Nottinghamshire County Council.

Died on 20 May 1995.
