Edward Patrick DUFFIELD (1898 - 1995)

Represented the Essex Association on the Central Council from 1936 – 1938 and attended 1 meeting

Born at Tasburgh, Norfolk on 21st December 1898.

Began ringing at Tasburgh in 1909 and was attached to St Peter, Colchester from 1926.

Rang his first peal on 18th January 1912: Plain Bob Major at Pulham Market, Norfolk.

His notable achievements include: ringing a peal of 15312 Cambridge Surprise Maximus (Ashton under Lyne, 5th August 1929); ringing in a family peal by father and five sons (Plain Bob Minor, Long Stratton, 27th December 1927).

He was an excellent heavy bell ringer.

He featured in the Ringing World article 'Personalities of the Exercise' No 41 (RW 13.10.1961).

Occupation: Miller.

Died on 5th January 1995.
