Ewart Harold EDGE (1926 - 2006)

Represented the North Staffordshire Association on the Central Council from 1960 – 1965 and attended 1 meeting

Ewart Harold Edge was born on 9th February 1926 at Wolstanton, Staffordshire.

He learned to ring whilst he was studying at Oxford University.

He was attached to Wolstanton until about 1989 when he started to ring at Astbury for a short while before moving to Congleton.

He rang some peals, but his great love was tower grabbing; he rang in over 4800 towers.

He was Secretary of the North Staffordshire Association 1953-1959. He wrote a history of the Association for its centenary in 1982.

He was a member of the Universities Association and organised many of their summer ringing weeks.

His other interests included painting - he was an accomplished artist - medieval history, ceramics, playing bridge and stamp collecting.

He spent his working life in the pottery industry.

He died on 19th April 2006. His funeral was held at All Saints, Odd Rode, Cheshire, where he is buried in the churchyard.
