Charles Henry JONES (1897 – 1980)

Represented the North Wales Association on the Central Council in 1924
and did not attend the meeting

Charles Henry Jones was born in Buckley in the second quarter of 1897.

He started ringing at Buckley in 1914 and quickly learned to ring Stedman . Later he became Vice-Captain of the band. He rang seven quarter peals. All these were quarters of Stedman.

Charles was the North Wales Association Secretary from 1920-1925.

The Buckley band rang a quarter peal of Stedman Triples on the occasion of Charles' wedding on 10th February 1926 when he married Mabel Blodwen Griffiths at Mold. Shortly after his wedding he left Buckley for Grimsby in order to take up work there as a clerk for British Railways. Some time later he left Grimsby and continued his employment as a railway clerk at Harrow, where he lived until at least 1948.

He died in 1980 in the London area.
