T Norman JONES (1897 – 19??)

Represented the North Wales Association from 1926-1933 and attended no Council meetings.

T. Norman Jones was born in Bangor in 1897 and later rang there. He lived in a street called Lon Pobty, which is an area of old three-storey terraced houses. In the 1911 census he was still at school but also worked part-time as a boot-maker's errand boy.

He rang two peals, both of them Grandsire Triples.

He was Secretary of the North Wales Association from 1925-1928.

The date and place of his death is not known.
