Alice Elizabeth Joyce LESTER (1939 – 2004)

Represented the Suffolk Guild on the Central Council from 1963 to 1966
and attended 4 Council meetings

Alice Elizabeth Joyce Lester was born at Ipswich on May 15th 1939.

She learned to ring in 1954 at Barking in Suffolk, where she rang her first peal, treble to seven Minor methods, on April 15th 1955.

Later she was attached to Our Lady and St. Nicholas, Liverpool from 1958-1960.

She rang in several multi-method Minor peals: on May 25th 1966, she rang 100 methods; on June 29th 1966, she rang 143 methods and on July 13th 1966 she rang 148 methods.

She was a teacher by profession and on 10th September 1966 she went to Singapore to teach at the British Army Children's School for two years.

There was an article about her in *The Ringing World* of August 5th 1966.

She died on 7th February 2004.
