Thomas METCALFE (1888 – 1965)

Represented the Cleveland and North Yorkshire Association on the Central Council
from 1913 – 1936 and attended 1 meeting

Thomas Metcalfe was born in 1888 in Dalton in Furness in Lancashire

He rang at Dalton in Furness all his life and was a ringer there for over 65 years.

He rang 32 peals of which he conducted one.

In 1911 his occupation was given as a steel moulder.

He was a lifelong member of the St. John's Ambulance Brigade, being superintendent at Dalton 1923-1948. He was treasurer of the Dalton branch for many years until his death.

He died on 3rd December 1965 at Dalton in Furness, where his funeral was held.
