Rognvald St. Clair WILSON (1928 – 2000)

Represented the Scottish Association on the Central Council
from 1954 to 1972 and attended 2 Council meetings.

Rognvald St Clair Wilson was born in Edinburgh on July 12th 1928.

By profession he was a solicitor and notary public.

He learned to ring in October 1946 at St. Mary's Cathedral in Edinburgh. He was the Secretary and Treasurer of St. Mary's Cathedral Society from 1950-1951. Later he became a member of St. Cuthbert's Edinburgh band, where he was Tower Captain for many years.

He was Secretary and Treasurer of the Scottish Association from 1950 to 1972, when he was elected President. He remained as President until 1978.

He was an Honorary President of the University of Edinburgh Guild.

He served on the Central Council Broadcasting and Television Committee between 1961 and 1972.

He rang his first peal on 13th August 1949 for the Universities Association at Ide in Devon.

He died on June 1st 2000.
